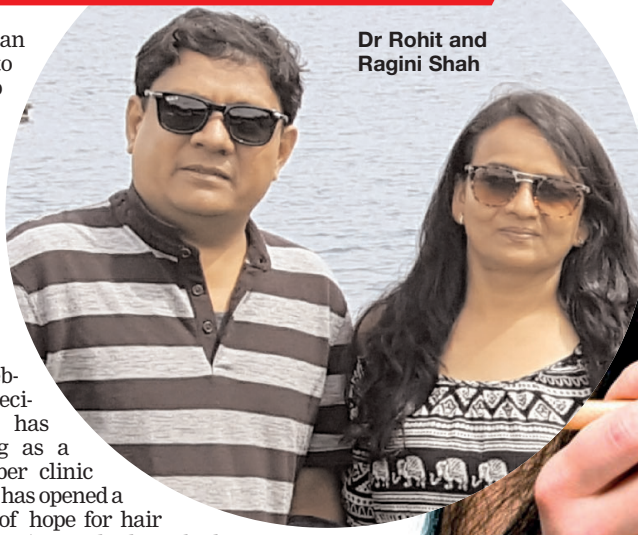

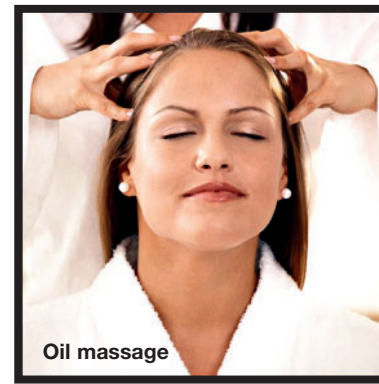
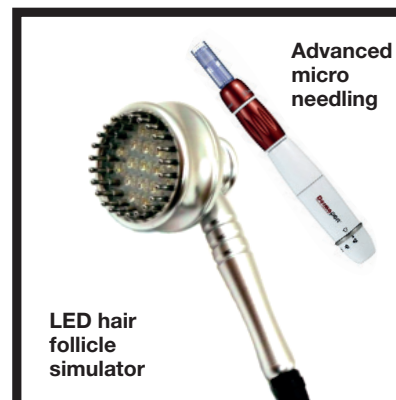
and progress to total scalp hair loss or complete body hair loss. Losing hair can be a traumatic experience especially when there is no reason found.
